- 1. The Ministry of Go and Love Foundation:

- 2. Myanmar Ministries:
- a. Pray for peace in Myanmar: May everyone have the fear of God, so that the civil war in Myanmar can end quickly, and the social problems caused by the war such as material shortage, rising prices, and turmoil can be alleviated as soon as possible, so

that more people can understand the gospel and be willing to accept the salvation of Jesus Christ.

- b. The Chinese school in Myanmar will open on March 1, and at the end of February, Minister Cao will take his children to Lashio to enroll. At present, both northern Myanmar and Lashio are in extraordinary times. Pray that God will lead and protect the teachers and children so that they can attend classes on time in Lashio and Namsalup.
- c. The ongoing civil war has led to an increase in conscription in Myanmar, whereby women between the ages of 18 and 27 may also be called up for military service. In particular, the Dai army is now recruiting next to the New Life Drug Rehabilitation Center of Mengsu, so many young people are very scared, and the co-workers and brothers are also very nervous. Pray for God's mercy and protection, and in remembrance of Pastor Yang's efforts. May more people trust Jesus, who alone can bring true peace to mankind.
